What should I do in case of emergency?

What do I do if I have problems or damage to my room or building?

What can I do if my Campus Card does not work?

Go to the front desk of your community or to the 24 hour desk for assistance.

Can I smoke on campus?

Where can I get ice?

Ice is available at the resident hall desk or the community center.

Where can I do laundry?

Laundry facilities are available in the basement or first floor areas of our residence halls and in the community center for Apartments.

How can I connect to the WiFi on campus?

Choose UMBC Visitor access. WIFI is free with no password.

Where and how do I find parking on campus?

Ask the desk in your building or the 24 hour desk for a parking pass. You can park in Zone A & Z, please refer to the campus map for directions to the parking zones. Improper parking may result in citations and monetary fines.

Where can I find an ATM machine?

ATM's are located outside of the University Center on the lower level and another in the Commons building on Main Street.

Can I receive and send mail?

The post office on campus is located in the first floor of the University Center. The hours are: Monday-Friday 8:30am to 4:00pm. If you would like to receive mail on campus please address it to Residential Life; c/o name of conference group with mailing address.

What public transportation is on campus?

MTA public bus line 35, 77, & 99 stop on Hilltop Circle. Bus schedules are available at the Commons main desk.

Is there a phone on campus that I can use?

Individual rooms do not have telephones, however each community has a public phone for local calls. Long distance calls require a calling card to be purchased by the individual.

Where can I make photocopies?

You can make photocopies in the Commons at the main desk or at Common Vision on the 3rd floor of the Commons. Prices vary based on project.
