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FALL 2019 MOVE-IN GUIDE**STEP 1: ARRIVING TO CAMPUS**

- Enter campus using the route indicated on your move-in [map](#).
- Follow the directional signs and instructions given by University Police and traffic attendants.
- Traffic attendants will provide you with a color-coded unloading permit, which will allow you to drive up to your hall and community before parking in the free parking zone.

STEP 2: UNLOADING AT YOUR BUILDING

- University Police will help direct you to the unloading zone closest to your residence hall. Our goal is for each vehicle to remain in the unloading zone for no more than 15 minutes in order to keep the move-in process traffic flowing steadily.
- A licensed driver must be with your vehicle at all times.
*It's best to have at least three people in your party, so the driver can move your vehicle out of the Unloading Zone (within 15 minutes after you pull in) while the student is inside getting their room keys and a passenger stays with belongings that have been unloaded onto the curb. We understand this may not be possible and will have tags available to mark unloaded items.
- Unload belongings at the curb, we'll direct your driver to a FREE all-day parking lot, and we will tag your items so we know they belong to you!
- A shuttle is available from the parking lot to bring you back to the building!

STEP 3: RESIDENT CHECK-IN

- Residents, go to your community check in location, with just your UMBC ID Card to complete the check-in process. Others in your party should stay with your items or move your vehicle.

STEP 4: Moving In

- Return to your items and proceed with them to your room. Moving bins and/or movers will be available to assist you!
