


# What is Housing Selection?

Housing Selection is the process by which current students choose their room and roommates for the upcoming academic year.

Students are <u>guaranteed housing</u> for the upcoming academic year if they participate in the Housing Selection process.



Things to consider before March



Clear any student account holds




Budget & plan to pay the \$200 Reservation Fee



Determine where you are eligible & interested in living



Use the Housing Selection Assistant to navigate the process



# Make a Choice

Undergraduate students with at least 39 <u>completed</u> credits may be able to choose to participate in the Walker Avenue or the Residential Life Housing Selection process.

Eligible students cannot participate in both processes.

### Walker Avenue Eligibility

#### Academic Status

- Must be a currently enrolled U resident or commuter who completed a "Commuter Pass a current resident, and
- Must either be enrolled as a graduate student or be an undergraduate student with 39 completed credits by March 1

If you meet all criteria you will be granted access to the Walker **Avenue Housing Selection** Application on March 1, 2023.

Must be one of the first 500 students to fully submit their Walker Avenue Housing Selection Application, License, and \$200 Reservation Fee, as space is limited at Walker Avenue.

Residents who do not make the cut-off may have the option to:

- and participate in Residential Life housing selection, or
- housing waitlist and Walker Avenue referral list.



\*The Walker Avenue Housing Selection Application will close on March 10, 2023 at 5PM or when 500 individuals have applied, whichever occurs first.



### Residential Life Eligibility

#### **Academic Status**

- Must be a currently enrolled UMBC resident or commuter who completed a "Commuter Pass" with a current resident.
- Must be an undergraduate student, who did not complete a Walker Avenue Apartment's Housing Selection Application (March 2023).

If you meet all criteria you will be granted access to the Residential Life Housing Selection Application on April 1, 2023.

#### **Good Financial Standing**

Must be in good financial standing. Students with outstanding student account balances greater than \$250 will not be granted access to the application.




As part of the application you will be required to acknowledge the Housing License (contract) and pay a \$200 Reservation Fee.



While there are questions on the application about your housing preferences, the application does not determine where you will live. You will have the opportunity to pick your room during Room Selection.



### 1 Application





Students that submit an application & decide not to live on campus will be assessed a cancellation fee.

Students that do not fully submit an application will not be guaranteed housing and cannot participate in selection.

### Options if you miss the application deadlines


If you miss the Walker Ave deadline or cut-off, you may be eligible to participate in the Residential Life Housing Selection process.

Forming a roommate group is optional

Please note that participating as an individual does not guarantee you will get a single room



You can find roommates on the housing portal or at a roommate social



If you form a group, it must be a group of 2 or 4



You can only form a roommate groups with those students who have completed the same application type as yourself

Step 3 Selection

Your selection time will be sent to your UMBC email at least two days before the start of the selection period.

Selection times are assigned based on your group's average completed credits and the selection process in which you are participating. If you are not part of a group, your time is assigned based on your completed credits.

Times are not prioritized by group size or class year.





The group leader must log into the housing portal during the assigned selection time to pick a room from the available inventory.

Some buildings or communities may not be available for you to select, as they may be dedicated for first-year students and/or Quarantine & Isolation housing.

Residential Life cannot stress how important it is that students pick a room. It's better to pick something and contact our office after selection to see if a change can be made, then to not select anything and be assigned in the summer to whatever spaces remain.
